"Shows have been cancelled quite a number of times. I really don't know what happened exactly. But reports said that we left the sets in anger. We did not leave in anger. We left as he had not reached the sets till then. He is a friend," said Ajay Devgn to media reports.

He further stated, "When I'll talk to him next, well get to know what was wrong. Kapil must have had some problem. But I really don't know. So, if there is anger or not, I can't really answer your question."

Ajay Devgn was here with the whole cast of Baadshaho in connection with the promotion of the film which is slated to release on September 1.
