

Mumbai might remain open 24x7 on New Year



Shiv Sena leader Aaditya Thackeray is pushing CM Devendra Fadnavis to grant the permission for Mumbai establishments and shops to remain open for whole night on New Year, and also at cities like Thane, Pune and Navi Mumbai.

Once again, Mumbai might remain open 24x7 on New Year's Eve as Shiv Sena youth wing chief Aditya Thackeray wants to give Mumbai a present. Thakrey is pushing the Maharashtra government to remain open all night on New Year citing country's financial and entertainment hub need "more space and time to unwind after hours of work".
